Appendix I – Coronavirus updates

This policy runs alongside the detailed school Coronavirus Risk Assessment.

Staff have a key role in advising the Headmaster on the effectiveness of the policy and procedures. They also have responsibility, with the support of the Headmaster, for creating a high quality, safe, learning environment, teaching hygienic habits and positive behaviour for learning.

Students are expected to take responsibility for their own hygiene and behaviour and will be made fully aware of the school policy, procedure and expectations.

In line with this coronavirus appendix pupils will be expected to:

- Follow any altered routines for arrival or departure
- Follow instructions on hygiene, such as handwashing and sanitising
- Follow instructions on who they can socialise with at school
- Move around the school as per specific instructions (for example, one-way systems, out-of-bounds areas, queuing).
- Understand expectations about sneezing, coughing, tissues and disposal (in line with the "catch it, bin it, kill it" message) and avoid touching their mouth, nose and eyes.
- Tell an adult if they are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus.
- Follow rules about not sharing any school equipment or other items including drinking bottles and packed lunch boxes

Teachers (or any other members of staff) are entitled to:

- Be able to enjoy teaching, or to carry out their job, without safety concerns and unacceptable pupil behaviour

Parents are entitled to:

- Information on how positive, safe, behaviour is promoted and what they can do to help

Parents have a responsibility to:

- Encourage their son or daughter to recognise the importance of good hygiene as an integral part of safe learning
